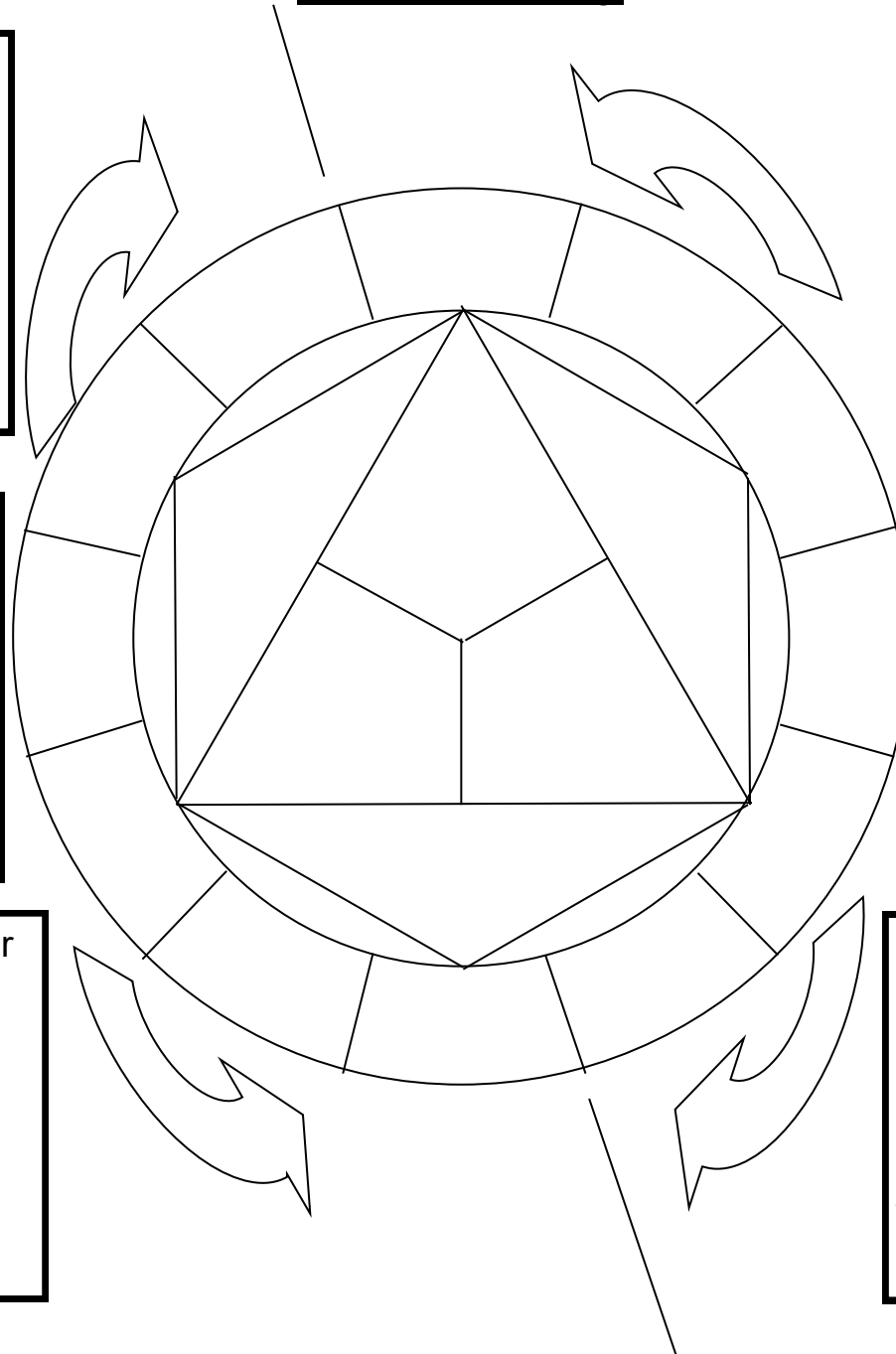


Colour Theory
