

Play Area Designing Exercise

JD International are a major developer of new schools. They have been asked to build a new school in PERTH, but need a little help on a few details. They are very good at designing buildings but not very good at designing things for entertaining pupils.

Your first task is to come up with a theme for three play areas for JD International. You will have to design all the things to go in each of these areas to keep people interested and enjoying the area. The designs need to be detailed so you will need to include notes and indicate what features are on each of the designs. All the designs should be on one side of an A3 sheet of paper and remember to put as much detail into them as you can think of.

Your second task is to plan out the whole area. You should include other things such as paths, seats and other play areas you require. Remember to think big with your ideas as JD International need to be impressed with your ideas to give you the job. The plan of this area should be drawn as a plan view (BIRDS EYE) looking down over the whole area. Do this on the other side of your A3 sheet and once again make notes to give as much information as you can for these ideas.
