- Function What does it need to hold?
- Aesthetics What will it look like? Shapes, colours, textures, theme?
- Construction Materials What will it be made out of? How will it be put together – glue, screws, etc?
- Ergonomics How will we use it? What size does it need to be? Will it be lightweight? Will it be easy to move?
- Safety Will there be any sharp parts? How will it all fit together?


Recording Measurements
